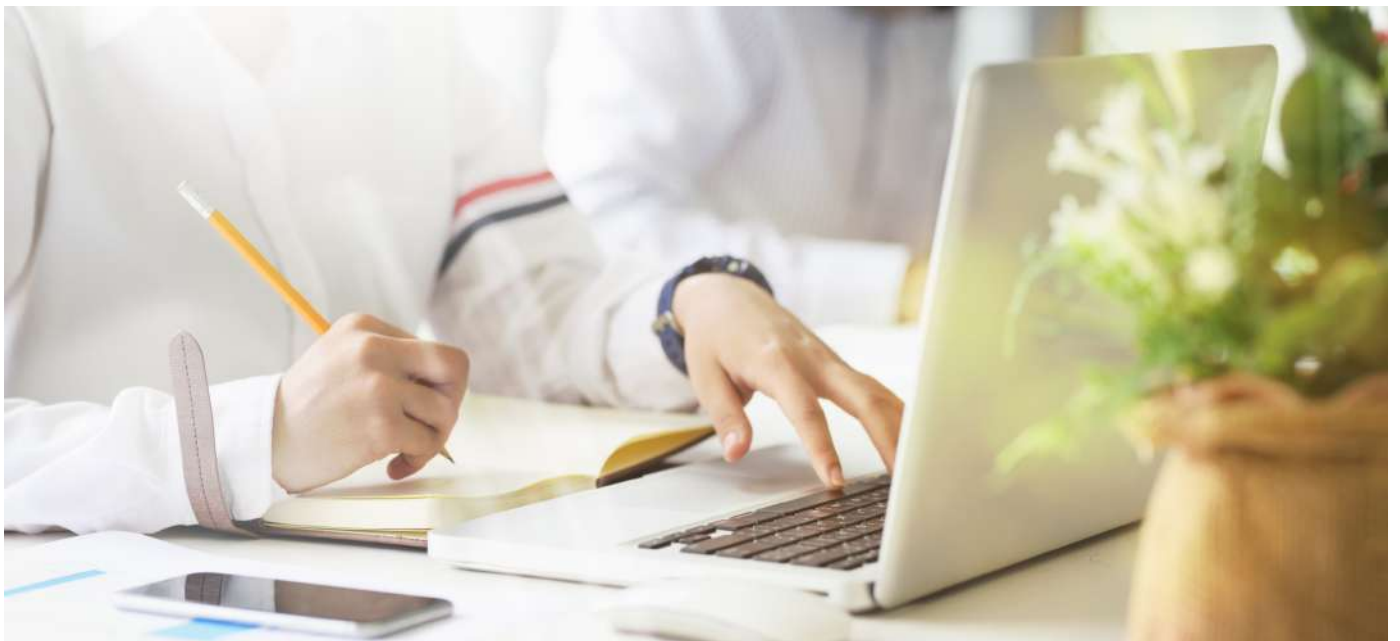
# ABOUT JUDICIAL ADDA





## **2. MAIN EXAMINATION:**
