


ABOUT JUDICIAL ADDA

NATIONALITY

No candidate shall be eligible for the appointment:

- 1. If he/she is not a citizen of India.
- 2. If he/she is compulsorily retired, removed or dismissed from judicial service or from service in Government or Statutory or Local Authority or failed to complete probation period in judicial service on any post, or in Government or Statutory or Local Authority.
- 3. If he/she has been convicted for an offense involving moral turpitude or he/she is or has been permanently debarred or disqualified by the High Court or the Union Public Service Commission or any State Public Service Commission from appearing for examinations or any selections conducted by it.
- 4. If he/she directly or indirectly influences the Recruiting Authority by any means for his/her candidature.
