


ABOUT JUDICIAL ADDA







Step 4- Subscribed Courses shall be visible here, if you have subscribed the course.



HIMACHAL PRADESH PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION H.P. JUDICIAL SERVICE COMPETITIVE EXAMINATION

SCHEME OF EXAMINATION:

PRELIMINARY EXAMINATION:

The preliminary examination shall be an objective type examination consisting of the following three papers of 100 Marks each:-

- 1. Civil Law-I
- 2. Civil Law-II
- 3. Criminal Law

Each paper shall be of one-hour duration and the examination in all the three papers shall be held on the same day. The syllabus for the preliminary examination shall be the same as provided for Paper-I to III for the Main examination. The preliminary examination will be held on 05/03/2020.

The result of preliminary examination will be declared on 15-03-2020 and shall be published and also displayed on official website of the Commission. No individual intimation shall be given to the candidates. CENTRES OF EXAMINATION: Udicial Adda

The Preliminary Examination will be held at SHIMLA, MANDI and DHARAMSALA in Kangra District.

The centres of holding the examination as mentioned above are liable to be cancelled/changed at the discretion of the Commission. Every effort will be made by the Commission to allot the candidates to the centre of their choice for examination, however, the Commission may, at their discretion allot a different centre to a candidate, when circumstances so warranted. No application for change of centre or any other entry in the application form shall be entertained.

2. MAIN (NARRATIVE) EXAMINATION:

- (i) Main Written (narrative) examination shall be held w.e.f. 30th March, 2020. The date sheet will be put on the website of the Commission. No individual intimation will be given.
- (ii) Each paper will last for three hours. The subject and syllabus for main(narrative) examination and marks for each paper shall be as follows:

Viva-voce	 (i) Candidates, who qualify the Main written examination, will be required to appear at such place, as may be fixed by the Commission, for a viva-voce test. The maximum marks for the viva voce shall be 150. The marks obtained in the viva-voce will be added to the marks obtained in the Main written examination for purpose of selection of the candidates. (ii) The summoning of the candidates for viva-voce test conveys no assurance whatsoever that they will be selected or recommended. Appointment orders to the selected candidates will be issued by the Government. (iii) A candidate shall also be required to obtain at least 45% of the marks allocated for the interview, failing which he will be deemed to have not qualified the competitive examination. 	150
